RE: **ANNUAL HEALTHY AND SAFE SCHOOL REPORT- April 8, 2024**

The North Marion School District is committed to providing a learning environment for our students, staff and community that is environmentally safe and healthy. In 2017, the Oregon Legislature passed Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 581-022-2223, which requires school districts to develop a Healthy and Safe Schools Plan to address environmental safety concerns. Including: a plan(s) for testing district-owned buildings for radon, test and reduce exposure to lead in water used for drinking or food preparation, to reduce exposure to lead paint that includes the following compliance with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair, and Painting Program Rule. A plan to implement Integrated Pest Management practices, and to communicate results for all tests required under the Healthy and Safe Schools Plan.

NMSD HAAS is in compliance and meets the requirements.

- The District is in compliance with the Radon testing requirements. The next radon testing is due in 2029.
- The District is in compliance with the Lead and Copper testing requirements. The next lead testing is due 2028.
- The District has completed five (5) chemical pesticide/ herbicide applications by an approved Commercial Applicator to date this year (next application this April 26, 2024). The applications have complied with the School District's Integrated Pest Management Plan and meets the Low impact Pesticide list.
- David Shultz is current on IPM training and grounds/custodial support staff are scheduled for August 14, 2024 for our next training.
- The District is doing our weekly, monthly and annual testing as required by Marion County Health for the district's drinking water and discharge water.
- The District is in compliance with Marion County Health's requirements for testing.
- There has been no asbestos abatement in the school district to date this year. The 3-year asbestos inspection is due November 2024.
