Re: 2022 Lead Testing Results

All school districts, education service districts, and public charter schools are required to test for and eliminate exposure to elevated levels of lead in water used for Drinking and Food Preparation through either remediation or eliminating access, according to OAR 333-061-0400 and OAR 581-022-2223. In conformance with those administrative rules, North Marion School District has developed a plan that meets the requests of the Oregon Department of Education and the Oregon Health Authority.

Our lead testing plan for North Marion School District 15 certifies the following:

1. Identify sources of lead following the EPA 3 T's technical guidance; Stop access; Communicate; Mitigate and correct; continued Monitoring. 2. All testing was done according to the testing requirements in OAR 333-061-0400;
3. All samples were analyzed by a lab accredited by Oregon Health Authority to test for those materials;
4. All water fixtures required to be tested under OAR 333-061-0400 were tested for elevated levels of lead in accordance with the testing schedule developed by the Oregon Health Authority; and
5. The testing schedule for each building is every 6 years, the next scheduled testing will be 2028FY.
