Nestled in Oregon's Marion County, the North Marion School District serves the communities of Aurora, Donald, Hubbard, Broadacres, and Butteville. With approximately 1,644 students enrolled across four schools on a single campus in Aurora, North Marion offers a close-knit learning environment with a focus on personalized attention.

Academics: The district emphasizes a strong core curriculum with a growing reputation for its technology integration. This blend of tradition and innovation equips students with the foundational knowledge and skills necessary for success in a rapidly changing world—especially in the area of Career & Technical Education (CTE).

**Community:** North Marion fosters a strong sense of community. The district maintains open communication with families and actively seeks their input. Collaboration with local businesses and organizations expands available resources and creates a supportive network for students. A recent bond in 2017 increased CTE options, offerings, and support for students.

**Challenges and Opportunities:** Like many rural districts, North Marion faces challenges

such as limited resources and fluctuations in enrollment. However, the district leverages its small size to create a personalized learning experience. Additionally, North Marion actively pursues grant opportunities and partnerships to expand its offerings and provide the best possible education for its students.

The district has one primary school (PK-2), one intermediate school (3-5), one middle school (6-8) and one high school (9-12) all set on 72 acres in a rural setting on a single campus.
